To accomplish the Ruby Jubilee Vision, during the period under report the Gospel committee could construct and complete 4 Church buildings with an uniform plan and an expenditure of Rs. 2 .5 lakhs to 3 .5 lakhs each at Thimmapur, Mangal Thanda, Peerjadiguda and Mabbukunta (Kundanvanepalle) villages with in a record time of 20 to 23 days each Church. For the completion of the Churches with in the record time the committee acknowledges the support and assistance of the Sr. Pastor Rev .Dr. G. Samuel and the President Mr. G. Jayakar David and the contractor Mr. B. Abraham.

New Gospel Centres : A new gospel centers was opened at Jinnaram village near Vikarabad R. R. Dist for the benefit of 30 families in the village. 10 individuals baptized with the efforts of Pastor J.Yugander, B. C. Darmapur and became the members of the Church.

COUNSELLING AND FOLLOW-UP MINISTRIES

Every Sunday, both in the Telugu and English Service many members and non-members, touched by the word of God are responding to the Altar Calls for whom counseling is done soon after the services.

Many of such respondents are accepting Jesus Christ as their Lord and Saviour and are attending Baptismal classes, held on Mondays and Saturdays and taking Baptism to testify the sovereignty of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ and be a witness to the outside world.

All new visitors who attend Sunday worship services for the first time are also being ministered by the Counseling and Follow-up Ministries team and their prayer requests are taken care of by the chaplains.

I sincerely appreciate the services of Mr. Vijay Kumar Cormaty and his committee members in leading these ministries.

BAPTIST CENTRE-INDIA

The Baptist Centre India is a beautiful place located 23 KM away from city on Nagarjunasagar High way. It consists of 17.5 acres of land, after acquisition of 1.5 acres of land by government for Krishna water pipe line. Our Church has constructed "Prayer Mount Baptist Church" on the hillock and Multipurpose Building on the ground measuring 7200 sq. feet and 15000 sq. feet respectively. The Multipurpose building is now utilized to accommodate the inmates of Old Age Home of our Church run by Baptist Trust. The attendance of our Prayer Mount Baptist Church has improved compared to last year because of sincere efforts by the Pastor Ch.Krishna Paul.

The construction of Ruby Jubilee complex of about 25,000 Sft at BCI is done with full phase and 2 blocks plan with G + 2 Floors has been planned by the architect Mr. G.Shyam Kumar. The execution work is carried out by BCI Director Personally and a pool is also build for the benefit of inmates. The shell work is completed along with Ground floor Brick Work for 2 Blocks.

New Baptism Tub has been constructed near the church premises to give baptisms to the new believers.

I thank Hon. President Jutike Ananda Rao and special thanks to Mr. B. R. S. Nayak, the Executive Director and Board of Directors for their co-operation and encouragement for the above activities at Baptist Centre.

WOMEN'S COMMITTEE

The Ministry of the Women's Committee started with the observation of Mother's Day. The regular programs consist of visiting the sick, house visiting and conduct cottage prayer, prayer meetings on 1st and 4th Saturday. Every second Saturday, Women meet in the main sanctuary for prayer and worship and participate in CBWA meeting on third Saturdays of every month.

Women's Committee celebrated Mother's Day on 9th May 2009. All mothers who had attended were honoured and given gifts. The message was brought by our dear Sr.Pastor Rev.Dr.G.Samuel. The importance of Mothers' Day, role of the mother at house working place and in the Church was spoken by two senior members of our "Women's Committee".

On 8th August 2009 One Day Women's Retreat was conducted in the Church. Nearly 1000 women from our Church and various branch churches attended the retreat. All women who attended were blessed by the word of God that was brought by Rev.Dr.G.Samuel and by Rev. Dr.Joy Cherian.

Teacher's Day program was organized on 12th September (2nd Saturday) in a very simple way as A.P. was in mourning for the sudden demise of our C.M. Late Dr.Y.S.Rajasekhar Reddy. All the women spent more time in praying for the bereaved family of our C.M.Late Dr.Y.S.Rajasekhar Reddy. Message was given by Rev.V.Asher and prayed for all the teachers who has attended.

We are glad to inform you that Women's Committee has committed to raise funds to construct 2 churches (buildings) in the villages. These funds will be given to OCPM for the same.

So far they have visited about 85 houses, visited the sick in the hospital and at homes, they have visited and prayed for the bereaved families of our members who lost their dear ones.

Attendance on every 2nd Saturday has increased by good number.

I thank the Women's Committee President Mrs.G.Eva Samuel and other members of the committee for their commitment and exemplary service.

HYDERABAD BAPTIST TRUST

The Hyderabad Baptist Trust was established as a social arm of Baptist Church Hyderabad and was registered on 12th October, 1991 with headquarters at Baptist Church Hyderabad, to cater to the needs of the poor and neglected sections of the community irrespective of caste and creed, with Christian love and care in the name of Lord Jesus Christ. Home for Orphans and Poor : There are 57 children now in the home, residing on the third floor of Seva Sadan. I thank specially Mrs. G. Eva Samuel for looking after the needs of the children, keeping them in discipline and guiding them in studies.

Home for the Aged: There are seven in-mates in the Home. I thank Pastor Ch. Krishna Paul, who is looking after the Home for the aged, as the Home is located in Baptist Centre India.


